Definitions

Casket Grave Spaces

Basic, premium and premier spaces—single grave spaces designated as such based on location within the Cemetery.

City Polyguard—A protective outer casing that goes over a casket when placed in a grave.

Single vs. Double Depth—A single grave can be purchased for the interment of one casket. A double depth grave allows for the interment of two caskets, one on top of the other. This burial option has to be chosen prior to the first interment.

Cremation Options

Cremation Estate— A space that is 8' X 10' and is large enough to bury up to 15 cremains with one headstone.

Cremation Garden—A garden where cremains can be co-mingled with the soil. There is a public monument for an inscription of the name, year of birth and year of death.

Cremation Vault—A protective outer casing that goes over the urn.

Endowment Contribution— Funds that are endowed for perpetual care of grave sites which encompasses the mowing, watering, and fertilizing of grave sites.

Flat Stone—A cremation space with space for a flat marker.

Old Section Cremation Space—An older section area with space for a flat marker.

Upright Cremation Space—A cremation space large enough to fit an upright stone.
